6 Types of Working Genius

Discernment - can see possible problems, ask questions

Galvanizing - cheerleaders, recruiters, champion the cause and cast vision

Enablement - delegators, managers, make sure people are working within their skills

Tenacity - will do whatever it takes to get the job done
