God has placed seeds in your heart.

- What's the death valley in your life? What seeds are in that valley?

Don't be a victim.

- Can you tell a story of a problem you saw and how you chose to fix it, rather than complain about it?

The days of hoping for others to save our families are over. Pastor your kids.

- Brainstorm ways to pastor your kids. What are some parenting strategies and practices we can use to raise our kids to know Jesus.

Strengths-Based Leadership - Prioritize development of strengths.

- Have everyone share three of their strengths.
- How can you better utilize or build up your strengths?

James 2:17 Faith by itself isn't enough. Unless it produces good deeds, it is dead and useless.

- Think back to the first question. What is one way you could take action and do something about the thing you complain about?

Read Acts 20:22-28

- Respond to Pastor Mike's question: Have you ever wondered 'will anyone receive eternal death because you failed to take action'?

Urgency

- How many years until your kids are out of the house. Discuss the urgency this creates (should create) in how you relate to and raise them.

Water some seeds.

- What seeds do you sense God wants you to water in your life, or the lives of your family members?
